



Attestation on Geneva Business School's Accreditation and Certification

To whom it may concern,

This document aims to provide information on Geneva Business School's accreditation and certification.

The Swiss educational system and specifically its higher education subdivision is supported by internationally renowned public and private institutions. While public sector institutions and programs are recognized by the Swiss federal authorities, the private sector and institutions were not authorized to apply for this quality assurance process until recently. Due to this context, all Swiss private schools have opted for international accreditations or local certifications while complying with local and international higher education standards.

Geneva Business School holds:

- Since 2003, a American programmatic accreditation for all its programs from [IACBE](#) (International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education), an organization recognized by the [Council for Higher Education Accreditation](#) (CHEA) in the USA. Geneva Business School received its unconditional accreditation renewal in April 2019, which is valid until 2024.
- Since 2002, a Swiss Program Certification for its Geneva programs from [EduQua](#), a Swiss quality label organization supporting schools that provide adult learning and continuing education programs. EduQua is part of the [Swiss Federation for Adult Learning](#).
- An accreditation from [AASBI](#) (Association of Schools of Business International), an accreditor of qualified business schools worldwide that serve the public interest with academically rich and diverse student bodies.
- Since 2018, an approved center status by [Qualifi](#), an accrediting body regulated in the UK by the Office of Qualifications and Examinations Regulation ([Ofqual](#)).
- Since 2018, a Silver Learning Partner status with [ACCA](#) (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants), which allows students to gain the ACCA Advanced Diploma in Accounting and Business award, a professional qualification.
- Since 2019, a Three Palmes of Excellence award from [Eduniversal](#), a global ranking and rating agency specializing in higher education and specifically in business school education.



Constantly pursuing academic excellence, Geneva Business School actively seeks additional memberships and higher education accreditations in its continuing commitment to quality enhancement and to provide students with the best possible positioning in the marketplace for work or the drive to succeed as entrepreneurs. As a result, in 2019, the Swiss federal authorities considered Geneva Business School eligible to enter the process for the Swiss Institutional Accreditation. This pathway has only recently been made available to Swiss private schools, and the full process takes at least two years to complete.
